Please share these sites with your friends and neighbors, and if you are a member of a neighborhood email group, you can share these sites there with an announcement about the show. If you can, please print out a few of the flyers to post at local nurseries, coffee shops, workplaces, neighborhood bulletin boards, etc. There will also be promotional cards available at the March meeting.;

Since this is our major fundraiser, your participation would be greatly appreciated. Attached is a sign up sheet for volunteering. Please donate a few hours of your time to make our show and sale a great success.

Volunteers are needed for sales, display monitoring, information resource, and potting demos and JUDGING. This will be a ribbon judging show by our own members!

We encourage all members to bring out their plants to show off! And if you have any plants to sell, there are plant sale labels and plant lists attached to this mail. The club will take a 25% commission on your sales, and you will net 75%. We will not be purchasing any plants for sale, so we will depend on member and consignor sales.. This should limit our outlay and increase our income.

A suggestion is to have you pick out a colored sales tag for your plants so you can more easily identify which of your plants might be left over at the close of the sale on Sunday night

All members and families are invited to a Friday Evening sale and show viewing. There will be cookies and snacks. If you would like to share please bring some lite snacks to this event.

Also, if you could save bags and boxes to use in the sale area it would be greatly appreciated. Again, PLEASE, PLEASE volunteer. As past show volunteers have found, this is a lot of FUN!

#### SCVOS Show Sales Rules 2018

#### **Members:**

For the purposes of the Show and Sale, a member is one who has his yearly dues paid before March 1 of the current year.

#### Sale Plants:

Plants for sale are restricted to MEMBERS, and plant consignors arranged by the show chairman. Plants must be labeled as instructed by the show chairman and must be clearly priced in even \$.

A list of the sale plants must be provided to SCVOS before any plants are placed for sale.

Each plant for sale shall be labeled with the member's or consignor's code, and price tear off label.

The maximum number of plants for sale per member will be announced before the show.

At the discretion of the show chairman the number of member plants on display for sale at any time may be limited

.

A member who has plants for sale and is working in the sales area shall NOT try to preferentially sell his/her own plants over the club plants SCVOS will retain 25% of the sale price. The amount will be determined by the sale plant tags collected during the sale.

Members selling their own plants shall volunteer 4 hours in the sales area.

Proceeds to be returned to sellers will be based on the plant labels collected at the time of sale. We will do our utmost to be accurate, however, sellers should be aware that losses due to accidental mishandling of labels or theft may occur.

Orchids, other plants, and supplies may be sold.

California sales tax will be charged to the buyers.

## Santa Clara Valley Orchid Society Judging Divisions 2018

Individual plants will be judged under the listed divisions and classes in three categories, one category per household including off site growing areas. The 3 categories are:

Amateur: One who has won fewer than 3 trophies, other than ribbons, at any orchid show.

Intermediate: One who has won at least 3 but fewer than 15 trophies, other than ribbons, at orchid shows and is not a commercial grower.

Advanced: One who has won 15 or more trophies, other than ribbons, at orchid shows, and is not a commercial grower.

Note: in Classes A-8, B-8, C-8, E-10 F-7, plants may be entered in 2 classes,(seedling blooming for first time) and (the appropriate class in the appropriate division)

# SANTA CLARA VALLEY ORCHID SOCIETY 2018 SHOW SCHEDULE 67TH ANNUAL ORCHID SHOW AT THE WESTGATE SHOPPING MALL CAMPBELL AND SARATOGA AVENUES SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA April 6,7,8 2018

The show is open to any and all exhibitors, except commercial growers\*. The show committee encourages all growers to enter as many plants as possible to make this show an outstanding success. The Santa Clara Valley Orchid Society assumes no responsibility for damage to or loss of plants entered in the show.

Entries for individual plant judging must be presented to the entry clerk in the mall between 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM on April 6. Any entry presented after 7:00 PM will not be accepted. Judging will be on Sat. April 7 at 9:00 am. All plants must be removed Sunday April 8 at 5:00 PM but no earlier. Commercial \* orchid growers are not eligible for ribbons or trophy judging.

At the discretion of the judges, First, Second, and Third place ribbons will be awarded in all classes in all sections. Only plants correctly labeled and completely entered for ribbon judging will be considered. Any plant infected with insects or diseases will be removed from the show.

No plant may be entered for ribbon or trophy judging unless it has been owned and grown by the exhibitor for six months.

Meristem plants and Stem Propagations are not considered as seedlings.

\*A commercial grower is one who derives his income or a substantial part of it from the sale of orchids.
